# EVENT SANCTIONING AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made	and entered into this day of by and

WHEREAS, BIBA is a recognised and legal sa	anctioning body; and
WHEREAS, PROMOTER is a recognised	d and licensed promoter in the Country o

and shall be in accordance with the Association of Professional Boxing Commissions (APBC)
unified rules of professional boxing.
2. BIBA grants to the PROMOTER all promotional rights for the Event, including all local
sponsorship income. PROMOTER may, at its discretion, utilise the BIBA name, logo,
sanctioning certificate and ratings (the "Rights"), but only as relates specifically to Event.
PROMOTER shall safeguard, protect and defend the Rights against all third-party uses and
hereby states that it claims no right, title or interest therein, beyond the license granted herein.
3. The <b>PROMOTER</b> will receive all revenues derived from the promotion of the event
including but not limited to: ticket sales, program advertising, ring mat and corner post
advertising, venue advertising, food and beverage profit (if applicable).
4. The BIBA shall furnish the PROMOTER official BIBA rules which shall be used during the
Event and for all matters related thereto.

- 5. A BIBA official will explain the BIBA rules to the Event officials, judges, managers and fighters prior to the sanctioned Event and provide consultation concerning the BIBA rules prior to the Event on a reasonable, as needed, basis.
- BIBA shall certify all officials including judges, referees, and timekeepers, which shall be appointed by BIBA head office and paid for by the PROMOTER.
- 7. BIBA will provide a minimum of one (1) official to the Event as supervisor ("Supervisor") to oversee and officiate the Event. The Supervisor will receive three hundred and Fifty Pounds Sterling (£350) for events in the United Kingdom or four hundred and fifty euros (€450) for events in Southern Ireland as compensation, plus expenses and accommodation for this duty.
- 8. As the boxing commission that has jurisdiction of the Event the BIBA shall have final approval of the officials for the Event, including those that are licensed by other organisations.
- Compensation for BIBA provided officials are listed below

PLEASE NOTE: Championship bouts that A Class Referees are required, the cost of an A Class Referee is higher and just accounts for Championship bouts, for undercard bouts either the A Class or standard class referees are paid the standard rate.

For events with more than five (5) professional bouts two doctors are mandatory

<sup>\*</sup>Doctors fee may vary either up or down dependent on location of event.

- 10. The PROMOTER is responsible for all expenses including travel, hotel accommodations and food associated with the BIBA supervisor, inspectors judges, referees, and timekeepers involved in Event.
- 11. The BIBA Non-Championship Event Sanctioning fees are £50.00 (ROI €60) per contest and a refundable bond of £3,500 (ROI €4,550) must be lodged with BIBA head office at least fourteen days prior to the event to ensure funds are cleared by seven (7) days prior to event.
  PLEASE NOTE: For Televised events or those featuring Championship bouts an additional fee of 2% of Gate/TV fee revenue is payable.
- The PROMOTER shall provide gloves and all other equipment necessary for all BIBA sanctioned bouts and the Event.

The weight of gloves to be used in BIBA Sanctioned contests shall be as follows:

- Super Welterweight, up to and including Heavyweights, shall use ten (10) ounce gloves.
- Light Flyweights, up to and including Welterweights, shall use eight (8) ounce gloves.

The **BIBA** inspectors shall inspect the gloves of each contestant prior to the beginning of the contest to insure that the gloves are free of any foreign substance that could be detrimental to an opponent, and are properly laced and taped.

- 13. The amount and type of hand wraps to be used in BIBA Sanctioned contests shall be as follows:
- a) In all weight classes, hand wraps shall be restricted to thirty (40) yards of soft gauze not more than two (2) inches in width, held in place by not more than eight (8) feet of adhesive tape, one and one half (1 ½) inches in width, for each hand.
- Adhesive tape shall not cover any part of the knuckles when the hand is clenched to make a fist.

The BIBA Inspector shall inspect the bandages to insure that they comply with these and all local regulations.

14. The BIBA inspector shall verify before the contest that ring used for the contests shall be no

less than eighteen (18) feet (5,486m) nor more than twenty-four (24) feet (7,315m) by side

within the ropes.

15. All contestants are required to wear a mouthpiece during competition. No bout may

commence unless each contestant has a back-up mouthpiece in the corner. The round cannot

begin without a mouthpiece in place. If the mouthpiece is dislodged during competition, the

referee will call time and replace the mouthpiece at the first opportune moment without

interfering with the immediate action. Points may be deducted by the referee if he feels the

mouthpiece is being purposely spit out.

The MINIMUM medical coverage required for events sanctioned by the BIBA

Please note: though the above is the minimum standard, we do advise that a third doctor and a

Two Doctors

Four Paramedics

Two Emergency Equipped Ambulances

Please note: That it is a requirement of BIBA that the one of the doctors should be either an Emergency Response Trauma Specialist, Neurologist or anaesthetist.

17. The PROMOTER and the participating fighters in the Event and any fighter in any BIBA sanctioned event must be approved members in good standing with the BIBA prior to the official weigh-in and by signing this Agreement, also gives consent to submit, if required, to a pre-or-post fight urine test to detect banned substances in their respective bodies.

### PROMOTER and BIBA further agree that

- (a) This Agreement may not assigned by either party without the prior written consent of the other party. Subject to the foregoing limitation, this Agreement shall inure to the benefit of and be binding on the successors and assigns of the respective parties.
- (b) This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the United Kingdom. Any matter related to the enforcement or interpretation of this Agreement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts having jurisdiction over London, United Kingdom and the parties hereto submit to the personal jurisdiction and venue of such courts.
- (c) If any legal action is necessary to enforce the terms of this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees in addition to any other relief to which that party may be entitled.
- (d) This Agreement sets forth the entire agreement between the parties with regard to the subject matter of this agreement. No other agreements, representations, or warranties have been made by either party to the other with respect to the subject matter of this Agreement.
- (e) There is no third party beneficiary intended under this agreement.
