1) Ronny Gabel fought in England twice, 15th May 2009 & 24th March 2012. Can you confirm that he held a GBA license for these two fights?

- 2) Timo Hoffman fought in England on 23rd February 2013 on the Prize-fighter bill, can you confirm that he had a GBA license for that?
- 3) Are there any other GBA fighters who have fought on British Boxing Board of Control shows in the UK ?
- 4) Are there any British Boxing Board of Control fighters that have fought on GBA shows in Germany?
- 5) Can you confirm that BDB and other EBU governing bodies fighters, regularly fight on GBA shows in Germany?
- 6) Which of the World Sanctioning bodies does the GBA work with that has a common affiliation to the British Boxing Board of Control?

If you could give me this information it will help me over here with the BBB of C. I am meeting our lawyers tomorrow, to discuss this issue with them.

Is it possible for you to make a complaint to your Sports Minister in Germany that the British Boxing Board of Control is trying to prevent the GBA from operating in the UK in violation of E U law in relation to free movement of goods and services?
